L'ORIZZONTE E' UNA LINEA CURVA
The Horizon is a Curving Line

Opening, Tuesday, 23 April 2013 at 7:00 p.m.

The photographs in the exhibition present the evolution of Agostino Osio's artistry. Over the past few years, his gaze has dwelt on viewing the horizon as an inner place. The horizon, the structural element of his photographs, slices the image in half like a fine blade and opens it to the sky - which is never a secondary space - and to the sometimes pitiless physicality of the earth or the vastness of the sea.

The observer is carried along by the strength of these infinities, and if on the one hand his gaze draws back towards inner regions, on the other it opens towards the intangible: *the beyond-the-horizon*.

The exhibition also features a video by Agostino Osio that continues his studies of the elusive: the intangible and silent horizon, the utmost limit of separation and contact.

The artist has also created a site-specific project in which his photographer's eye reopens the space-time study within the exhibition space. He uses a column inside the gallery to observe and photograph the horizon line of the exhibition entitled *The Horizon is a Curving Line*, and presents it on that column in a perceptive game that develops like a fractal in the artistic experience.
